


### Code of conduct


- Every student shall come to the college in time and decent dress
- Every student is mandated to wear or carry his/her identity card, without which he/she will not be allowed into the college campus
- More than 75 percent attendance is mandatory for sitting in the annual/semester examinations
- Payment of the fee, every semester/or annually as the case may be is compulsory.
- Students are directly not to make noise or resort to hooliganism within the college campus. Such students taking part in such activities are liable to be punished.
- Students are prohibited from loitering in the corridors, and premises.
- Consumption of tobacco, alcohol, drugs, and all objectionable beverages is strictly prohibited
- Scribbling on board, desks, and walls is strictly prohibited and such acts will invite punishment.
- Engaging in harassment, or discriminatory behaviour based on religion, caste, creed, as well as disability is a punishable offense.
- Any attempt for ragging, assault, bullying, discrimination, threatening, violence, harassment, mobbing, and misconduct should be avoided in the college premises
- No student shall be allowed to leave the classroom without the due permission of the concerned class teacher
- Obstruction or disruption of teaching or other activities being carried out in the college will be viewed as misconduct, and those involved in such activities will be punished.
- Dishonesty, forgery, alteration or misuse of college documents, records, or identification, or knowingly furnishing false information is a punishable offenses.
- While representing the college, student's behaviour must not be detrimental to the image of the college
- Using cell phones within the class or in the corridors is completely prohibited, and the students found guilty of non-conformity will be expelled from the class, or the college.
- Students shall not bring outsiders to the college; no person should be invited to address a meeting on college premises



- Students are expected to take part in all the co-curricular or extracurricular activities and make use of the facilities being extended for their growth and excellence in their field of interest.
- Students shall not collect any funds from other students without the written permission of the principal.
- Students shall not organize picnics, excursions, trips, etc. without the prior written permission of the principal.
- Students enrolled for the PhDs will adhere to the ethical guidelines related to their publication work, and will strictly avoid plagiarism, which remains a cognizable offense.
- All the students shall give equal importance and seriousness to their internal assessment exam or projects assigned since it carries 25 percent marks.

The powers relating to the disciplinary action in the college will rest with the principal and his/her decision in this respect shall be final. Anyone who violates the code of conduct will be strictly dealt with.
