EXTENSION ACTIVITIES CARRIED OUT BY THE NCC, NSS, AND ROVERS & RANGERS

The college has instituted Rovers & Rangers, National Social Scheme (NSS), and NCC. On an annual basis, different programmes are run by these individual schemes, both within and especially outside the college premises. For example, NSS enrolled students are mandated to hold a camp outside the town itself, in say a village, for a minimum duration of 8-10 days, where while staying in the camp, they carry out social work, not just extending to cleanliness drive, which also involves uprooting weedy species from the fields, but more importantly holding awareness campaigns in the surrounding villages, holding Nukkad Nataks on socially-relevant issues such as sexual discrimination, sex-determination and abortion, women health-related issues, and so forth. During these stay the students too, get to learn the village environment, the agro-practices, the crops being grown and else, thus getting themselves enriched.

NSS as well as Rovers & Rangers students have in fact initiated their ideas, for example forming a copy bank, prepared out of the left-out pages from the copies, which are then bound into copies to be distributed to the socially as well as economically weaker segments of the society. This apart second-hand books or old books too are collected to be distributed to these poor and marginalized students. The Covid-19 pandemic offered opportunities to the NCC cadets to facilitate the local administration in various positions, such as distribution of masks, ration, managing the crowds during vaccination, as well as encouraging the locals to wear masks. Needless to say, a number of cadets were later on facilitated by the local administration for the role played.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2020-21

A 7-day NSS Camp was held from 5th April to 12th April 2021. The camp was inaugurated by the senior faulty, Dr. Sucheta Sah Mehta, Professor, Department of Zoology, M B Government Postgraduate College, Haldwani. The usual day of the camp started with the Yoga practice in the morning and then set out with the culmination of the day's objectives. The afternoon or evening hours were then spent in either organizing the cultural programs or talks by invited experts on various topics of relevance such as talk on medicinal plants by Shri Madan Bisht, Ranger, FTI, Haldwani; talk on AIDS and how to safeguard oneself by Dr. D C Paneru of Base Hospital, Haldwani; a motivation talk by Ms. Priti Priyadarshini; relevance of participating in sports activities by Dr. Bhuwan Tiwari, and a talk on communicable diseases and leprosy by Dr. Pramod Bhatt.

Total number of participants- 200

This year, the participants of the NSS were involved in carrying out the following broad subjects;

- 1. A cleanliness drive, in the parent college campus as well as its close vicinity.
- Raising awareness about the scourge of liquor and single-use plastics. An awareness campaign was organized from the college campus, through the main market to Golapaar-situated International Stadium. The awareness campaign also involved raising awareness about the pandemic Covid-19 and how to safeguard oneself against the same.
- 3. The highlight of this year's program involved organizing a blood-donation camp on the 5th day of the NSS Camp, in collaboration with the team of doctors and assistants from the Base Hospital Blood Bank as well as seeking the expertise from the Late B.K.D Joshi Charitable Blood Bank. 40 students either participated in the NSS Camp or else, donated their blood.

This apart, 7 students took an active part in raising awareness about Covid-19 and taking an active part in the Covid-19 vaccination drive. The names of these NSS warriors are the following- i.
