# A BRIEF REPORT OF THE SEMINARS, WEBINARS, ETC, HELD IN M B GOVERNMENT POSTGRADUATE COLLEGE, HALDWANI (NAINITAL) (2020-21)

### Summary

Altogether 4 separate webinars, workshops and Faculty development programmes were held. Organised by faculty of two different departments- Psychology and Sociology. These programmes were mostly held in collaboration with other institutes, viz., with Directorate of Higher Education, Government of Uttarakhand, or Uttarakhand Open University, Haldwani; and as in case of the FDP, with H N B Garhwal University, Srinagar (Garhwal). As could be gauzed from the table below, these programmes were primarily conducted in the mode of Webinars, since these were conducted during the interval of Covid-19 pandemic, where formal offline mode of seminar was just impossible. The success, and the very idea of conduction of the programmes was that these were primarily focussed for the benefit of the research scholars, as well as to general participants who would get benefitted out of the talks delivered by the experts in the subject of psychology, since a major or significant percentage of populace was definitely affected by the Covid-19 scare, if not directly, but indirectly too, through anxiety, depression, and so forth. Hence, the expertise extended by the Department of Psychology, in association with other experts was just the need of the hour.

Webinar on research methodology, with emphasis on practical hands-on training of the SPSS was another successful programme, which in fact enrolled participants from outside the state; as were the experts, too. The topics deliberated were judiciously selected as per the need of the enrolled research scholars, and efforts were thus made that no two speaker delivers on a same topic. The talks were definitely of benefit to the research scholars, as could be gauzed from the analysis of the feedback received from the participants. The total number of registered participants in all these 4 programmes was 602. However, it would be safe to conclude that the effective number was significantly large.

# Report 1: Two Days National Virtual Conference on "Covid-19 Pandemic: Voice of Youth – An urgent need of psycho-social support, 21<sup>st</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2020.

The two-day virtual conference was organised by the department of Psychology in collaboration with the Directorate of Higher Education, Government of Uttarakhand. A number of experts were invited to deliver expert talks to the students, and alike on issues related to the psycho-social issues born out of the Covid-29 pandemic. Tiwari, Associate professor, M J P Rohilkhand University, Bareilly; and (v) Covid-19- Causes and precautions by Dr. Ajay Pandey, M D. Paediatrist. Altogether around 250 students and teaching staff participated in the deliberations.

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





# Report 4: FDP on Ethics, Research methodology and Applied SPSS, 27<sup>th</sup> January to 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2021

A week-long Faculty development programme on the topic listed above was organised jointly by M B PG College with Government Degree College, Bhatronjkhan, Almora in collaboration with the Faculty Development Centre, H N B Garhwal University, Srinagar (Garhwal). The primary objectives of the course were to develop a research orientation among the scholars and to acquaint them with fundamentals of research methods. # एमबीपीजी के ४०० पीजी छात्र छात्रवृत्ति से वंचित

एमबीपीजी कॉलेज में पीजी के 400 से ज्यादा छात्र इस साल छात्रवृत्ति पाने से वंचित रह गए हैं। पीजी के दाखिले देर शुरू होने की वजह से पात्र छात्रों के आवेदन नहीं हो पाए थे। इसमें राज्य सरकार के अलावा केंद्र की ओर से छात्रवृत्ति पाने वालि विद्यार्थी शामिल हैं। इनके अलावा स्नातक प्रथम वर्ष की सुधार परीक्षा देने वाले भी छात्र शामिल हैं। अब स्कॉलरशिप पोर्टल दोबारा खुलने की संभावना कम है।

सरकार एससी, एसटी, ओबीसी के अलावा अल्प संख्यक, राष्ट्रीय छात्रवृत्ति, टॉप क्लास श्रेणी में विद्यार्थियों को छात्रवृत्ति प्रदान करती है।

कोरोना संक्रमण के चलते इस सत्र कॉलेजों में प्रवेश प्रक्रिया देर से शुरू हुई थी। एमबीपीजी कॉलेज से मिली जानकारी के अनुसार 20 जनवरी छात्रवृत्ति के लिए आवेदन की अंतिम तिथि थी। मगर कुमाऊं विवि से पीजी प्रथम सेमेस्टर में पंजीकरणकराने वाले छात्रों से सूची देर से मिली। इस वजह से मेरिट लिस्ट देरी से जारी हुई और प्रवेश प्रक्रिया में विलंब हुआ।

### **Objectives**

The Mental Wellness & Counseling Cell was established in February 2021 in the Department of Psychology. Mental health awareness is the ongoing effort to reduce the stigma around mental illness and mental health conditions by sharing our personal experiences. It's a youth-friendly cell where students can share any type of problems they are facing with the counselor as well as the psychiatrist, who would be visiting the Cell on the appointed date. It is well known that a significant number of youths are suffering from anxiety, which as per one study is around 9.4%, similarly depression (4.4%), and other behavioral problems, which again is around 8.9%. Towards amelioration of this growing mental health problem, the proposed mental Health & Counselling Cell will carry out the following-

- i. Hold talks with the youths to understand and sort out the problem
- ii. Educate them about mental well-being, through making social connections, or relations, so that they may be able to share their problems; lead an active mode of lifestyle, and take up or practice different modes of relaxation techniques.
- iii. Motivate them to raise or remain positive, and encourage them to get relived o their anxiety or fears, or any other emotional problems through an outlet, which could be friends, relationships, etc.
- iv. Taking recourse to the expertise available in the college, say, Department of Yoga, to undertake Yoga exercises for the benefit of the students suffering from anxiety, and else, through relaxation of mind.

v. One of the prime goals of the Cell would be to impart a sense of meaning and purposefulness in life, to the students.

### **Achievements of the Mental Health & Counseling Cell**

To date, around 400 students have benefitted from their visit to the Cell. Additionally, the Cell or the facility also holds workshops or awareness talks by inviting experts. The talks related to Mental Health issues. Henceforth, locally available expertise is sought in the form of clinical psychologists, counselors, and psychiatrists, from time to time. Needless to emphasize here, these talks have helped in raising awareness about the mental health-related issues amongst the youth, and have paved the way towards their behavioral, as well as emotional strengthening. The students are also involved in learning the basic techniques, and how to cope with the stressors and depressive symptoms.
