NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME REPORT FOR THE YEAR- 2021-22



A 7-day NSS Camp was held from 23rd March to 29th March 2022 in Government Primary School, Subhash Nagar, Haldwani. The camp was inaugurated by the senior faculty, Dr. M P Singh, Professor, Department of Sociology, and erstwhile In-Charge of the NSS, M B Government Postgraduate College, Haldwani. The usual day of the camp started with the Yoga practice in the morning and then set out with the culmination of the day's objectives. The afternoon or evening hours were then spent in either organizing the cultural programs or talks by invited experts on various topics of relevance such as drug abuse, plastics as the scourge of the environment, the relevance of Yoga in everyday life, busting the myth surrounding the blood donation, the relevance of participating in sports activities, child abuse and sex-determination, a talk and practical hands-on practice of the use of simple techniques of Acupressure points, etc.

Total Number of participants: 200

This year, the participants of the NSS were involved in carrying out the following broad subjects;

- 1. A cleanliness drive, not just in the aforesaid school's campus, but additionally also in the parent college campus as well as its close vicinity.
- 2. Raising awareness about the scourge of single-use plastics. This involved also hand-picking the plastics not just from the Susheela Tiwari Base Hospital, Haldwani, but extending the drive to Transport Nagar.
- 3. The highlight of this year's program involved organizing a Free-for-All Eye check-up camp in collaboration with the local Private Eye hospital- The Shubham Eye Hospital, Thandi Sadak, Haldwani, with the expertise of Dr. Bhanu Pangtey, Dr. Subha Pangtey, and their staff lending their help. Altogether, 155 individuals benefitted from this exercise.

4. A blood donation camp was similarly organized, where 20 students donated their blood.
