#### **ANTI-RAGGING CELL REPORT (2022-23)**

The anti-ragging committee was re-constituted as per the guidelines of University Grants Commission, New Delhi, vide letter F.No. 1-74/2016 (AR July 05, 2023/Aashad 14, 1945). The mandate of the committee remains to address or redress the issue of ragging (if any) within the college premises. The committee, however, will also be responsible for organising/raising awareness about anti-ragging, to hold competitions, such as poster, essay writing, debate, anti-ragging logo design, expert talks, and other such programmes to make the students aware about the ragging menace.

As per the directions of the University Grants Commission, New Delhi, vide letter F.No. 1-74/2016 (AR July 05, 2023/Aashad 14, 1945), regarding a week long (12<sup>th</sup> August to 18<sup>th</sup> August 2023) anti-ragging week, the anti-ragging committee organised the following programs as part of the awareness programme about the menace of ragging, and the redressal mechanisms available.

As part of the above mandate, Essay writing and poster competitions were held on 12<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> August, respectively; and on 18<sup>th</sup> August, two legal experts, Shri Harendra Singh Mehta, SO, Police Department (who has also been nominated as member of the Anti-ragging Cell, by the local Police Department) and Ms. Suchitra Belwal, Advocate, Divisional Court, Haldwani, were invited to give talks, primarily focussed on the redressal mechanisms available with the aggrieved students. A number of examples on the menace of ragging prevalent in some of the local medical and engineering institutes was highlighted by the speakers; the events which were very well covered by the local dailies, too, was brought forth, so that the students could relate themselves to such acts. It was decided that the mobile numbers of the In-charge of important redressal cells, like Student Grievances Redressal Cell, Sexual harassment (prevention, prohibition, and Redressal) Cell, Legal Cell, Anti-ragging Cell, Mental health & Wellness Cell, be made available to all the students, to make the redressal mechanism effective. Towards the end of the programme, a number of students too were invited to share their thoughts, not just on the subject matter of ragging, but other more relevant issues, such as sexual harassment.
